Wed 28 September 2016 – Steering Committee

Wed 28 September – morning session

Brief presentation of the representatives of the project partners attending the meeting.

Presentation of the logistic organization (AZS Poland) and of the meeting agenda (CSEN).

Overall project description: CSEN Italy outlined the state of the art of the project and presented a time schedule.

CSEN Italy outlined some aspects related to the use and utilization of the MOVE project web site, with particular reference to the methods for uploading project documents through the area reserved to each partner and to the platform for discussion called Wiki Move. A session to clarify the contents followed.

The Partners AZS Poland and HCA Bulgaria drew up a brief report on the project multiplier events edited in their countries. As regards the web site functioning, CSEN Italy reminded the methods for uploading the documents on the events in the web site and more in general, all documents and necessary fulfilments after the multiplier events.

Output 1: European report competences for activation: on the basis of the template edited by Roma 3 University – Education and Training Science – Italy and after submitting the questionnaires to sport coaches. The respective reports of the national researches were sent to the Bulgarian partner HCA before the meeting. During the meeting, a session for discussing strengths and weaknesses of national researches was held.

Wed 28 September – afternoon session

After presenting an abstract on the comparative report of national researches edited by HCA Bulgaria, the partners agreed upon the integrations to improve and finalize the final version of the comparative Report. See attached presentation.

The following step concerned the matters related to Output 2: research on what people think about sport activity. Submitting 600 questionnaires in total across all partner countries to all age groups, with particular reference to the young (18 – 29) and the elderly (over 55) who do and do not do sport activity. As envisaged by the project, the objective was to define the Questionnaire during the meeting in Poland. So,



on the basis of the work conducted on the template Output 2 and the questionnaire of the partner AZS Poland, a brainstorming session was held for the purpose of implementing the questionnaire. The goals stated by the partners were: calibrating the questionnaire tool upon the reference target; calibrating the tool upon the different national contexts. During the afternoon session on Wednesday, the revision concerned the first section of the questionnaire (sections: difficulty in sport; functions of sport; skills acquired through sport)

Thu 29 September – morning session

The morning session was dedicated to discussing, revising and defining, in subgroups and afterwards in plenary session, the closing section of the questionnaire (competences) with the aim to formulate the questions in an effective manner in relation with the target. See the attached questionnaire.

Thu 29 September – afternoon session

The afternoon session was dedicated to defining the template – proposed by AZS Poland in collaboration with Roma 3 University –so as to conduct the research starting from the questionnaires Output 2. See attachment.
